**IVANKA:** She [*the Gospa*] said that, I didn't.

**Father ZOVKO:** Who?

**IVANKA:** The Gospa.

**Father ZOVKO:** To whom did she say that?

**IVANKA:** To us. Mirjana has asked that.

**Father ZOVKO:** I know, did she tell you that?

**IVANKA:** I heard that. All of us heard that.

**Father ZOVKO:** Why should it be Judas since he had the faith like the rest of the apostles?

**IVANKA:** What do I know? When she [*the lady-physician*] touched her, she [*the Gospa*] left. She [*the lady-physician*] also said that she had seen the cloud when she [*the Gospa*] departed.
